• I drink tea daily.	• I am drinking tea now.
• She reads every night.	• She is reading now.
• They play after school.	• They are playing outside.
• We watch movies often.	• We are watching one.
• He drives carefully always.	• He is driving home.
• You cook delicious meals.	• You are cooking dinner.
• Birds fly very high.	• Birds are flying overhead.
• Children laugh loudly sometimes.	• Children are laughing now.
• My brother works weekends.	• My brother is working today.
• The shop opens early.	• The shop is opening now.
• Water boils at temperatures.	• Water is boiling now.
• Dogs bark at strangers.	• Dogs are barking outside.
• Teachers explain lessons clearly.	• Teachers are explaining today.
• The train arrives daily.	• The train is arriving now.

• Cats chase small mice.	• Cats are chasing one.
• Grandparents tell funny stories.	• Grandparents are telling one.
• My sister paints beautifully.	• My sister is painting now.
• The gardener waters plants.	• The gardener is watering them.
• People travel during holidays.	• People are traveling today.
• Workers start early daily.	• Workers are starting now.
• The nurse helps patients.	• The nurse is helping one.
• Drivers follow road signs.	• Drivers are following directions.
• The chef prepares meals.	• The chef is preparing lunch.

• The coach trains athletes.	• The coach is training them.
• Children draw colorful pictures.	• Children are drawing now.

• She feeds her cat.	• She is feeding it.
• They ride bicycles often.	• They are riding now.
• We discuss ideas regularly.	• We are discussing plans.
• He follows instructions carefully.	• He is following them.
• You send messages frequently.	• You are sending one.
• The child asks questions.	• The child is asking one.
• My brother enjoys cricket.	• My brother is enjoying practice.
• The vendor sells snacks.	• The vendor is selling them.
• People prefer healthy food.	• People are preferring lighter meals.
• The guard watches entrances.	• The guard is watching now.
• Students complete homework daily.	• Students are completing tasks.
• My mother decorates rooms.	• My mother is decorating today.
• The company hires workers.	• The company is hiring now.
• Guests arrive on time.	• Guests are arriving now.
• The fisherman catches fish.	• The fisherman is catching one.
