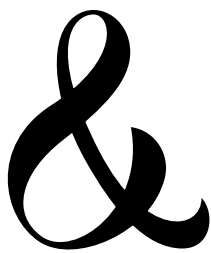
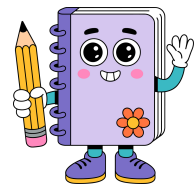

Past Perfect

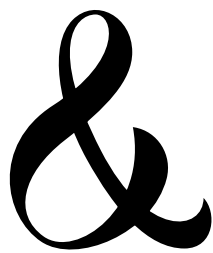


• I was working late.	• I had finished dinner.

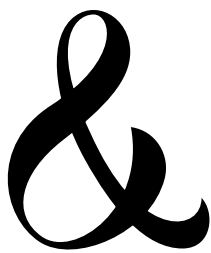

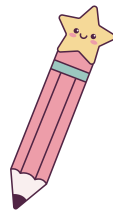

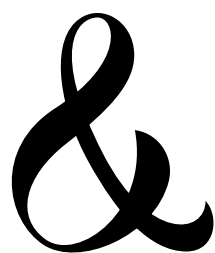
