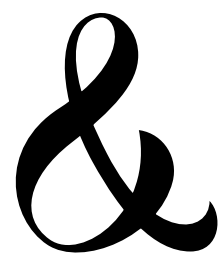

Present Perfect

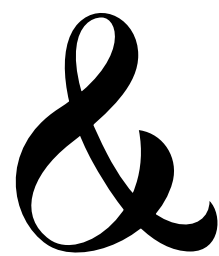


• Birds are flying low.	• We have finished lunch.

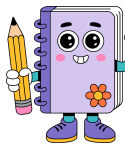

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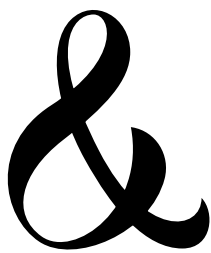
Present Perfect
